The AIPGF Principles...

... are overarching **guidelines** that serve as the **foundation** of the Framework.
... provide **clarity** on how to approach decisions regarding **AIPGF adoption**.
... shape the **mindset** required for **responsible AI use** in projects.

Human-Centricity, Transparency and Adaptability

- **Human-Centricity** ensures that AI serves as a collaborative partner rather than an independent actor, reinforcing human expertise and ownership.
- **Transparency** ensures that AI's role in projects is explainable and auditable, with clear human accountability for any AI-assisted deliverables.
- **Adaptability** ensures that governance of AI-assisted project environments remains practical, scalable and context-specific, evolving alongside an organisation's AI capabilities and governance structures.



The AIPGF encourages human-centricity, transparency and adaptability when using AI in project environments.

The three Principles shape the Framework and enable project teams to leverage AI capabilities while maintaining control and transparency, tailored to the organisation's specific AI adoption and project-specific context.
