

Who Needs to Know About the AI Project Governance Framework (AIPGF)?

Project Portfolio and Oversight Roles

Project Management Office (PMO) leaders, Enterprise PMO Leaders, Change Managers, Project Sponsors and Steering Committees/Boards:

- You are accountable to the organisation's board for ensuring AI use in projects and programmes is ethical, efficient and effective. You should **champion AIPGF adoption**.

Project and Programme Delivery Roles

Programme and Project Managers, Project Coordinators and Project Core Team Members:

- As users of AI tools in projects, you are responsible for ensuring the benefits of AI assistance are harnessed whilst the risks are managed. You need to uphold the Principles of human-centricity, transparency and adaptability and should **know how to practically integrate the AIPGF's guidance in your project processes**.

Governance, Risk and Compliance Roles

Chief AI Officers, Digital Transformation Leaders, AI Ethics Advisors, Internal and External Auditors, Legal, Compliance and Regulatory roles:

- As guardians of organisational integrity, **your role is to ensure that AI use in projects aligns with external standards and internal policy**. The AIPGF helps translate general AI standards and regulations into project-specific governance, ensuring AI risks are managed and accountability is clear.
